- Loveland Ski Area: Hit the slopes at one of Colorado's most popular ski destinations! Loveland is perfect for both beginners and more advanced skiers, with ideal runs for everyone!

Half-Day Excursions:

- Visit the Downtown Aquarium and Denver Museum of Nature & Science
- Enjoy ice skating with Denver's skyline in the background
- Take in the sights at Sixteenth Street Mall and City Park, two of Denver's biggest public attractions.
- Tour University of Colorado Denver, the largest research institution in Colorado

Sample Activities



Downtown Aquarium

With more than one million gallons of underwater exhibits, the Downtown Aquarium houses over 500 species of animals, a stingray touch-and-feed tank, and myriad ecosystem exhibits.

Denver Museum of Nature & Science

Learn about the natural history of Colorado, Earth, and the universe in this Smithsonian-affiliated museum. Explore the diversity of Native American groups, trace the evolution of life on Earth through stegosaurus and allosaurus skeletons, and embark on a space odyssey learning about our place in the Universe.

Loveland Ski Area Full-Day Excursion

Colorado is known worldwide for its light, fluffy snow—and Loveland Ski Area has plenty of it! The area receives 35 feet of snow each season on average. Loveland is perfect for first-time skiers, where you can improve your technique with gentle slopes. Experienced skiers also can enjoy more intimidating runs, with about 85% of them being intermediate and advanced. No matter your skill level, Loveland is a great place to enjoy the fresh mountain air and have fun!

Glenwood Springs Cavern Adventure Park Full-Day Excursion

Take cave tours, ride thrilling roller coasters, and experience breathtaking views of the Rocky Mountains at this adventure park on top of Iron Mountain. Go on the Cliffhanger Roller Coaster, North America's highest elevation coaster, and look at the Colorado River 1450 feet below! Alternatively, you can tour caves 150 feet down, where stunning rock formations abound.
